



Distance Learning Expectations

As we prepare to open our doors to our members this school year, our goal is to provide an encouraging environment for your child(ren) to learn through their schools' distance learning model. To achieve that goal:

- The morning will be comprised of Distance Learning, while the afternoon will reflect our traditional Club programming
- Members completing their Distance Learning assignments at the Club must bring their own device (laptop, etc.) and must sign our Technology Policy. The Club does not provide computers for Distance Learning
- Members must bring their own headphones for any Distance Learning that involves sound (so they can hear, and so they don't distract the other members)
- Boys & Girls Club staff will be available to assist members in accessing their Distance Learning, but they are not teachers and will not be able to provide instruction or individual assistance in completing assignments
- Members are expected to take responsibility for their learning
- Parents must communicate with their child's teacher if difficulty with distance learning arises
- Members not working on their Distance Learning assignments while at the Club will be expected to respect the quiet time so their peers can do their work
